

NFIP Extended Through September 30, 2019

On June 3, 2019, Congress passed the Additional Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Act, 2019 (H.R. 2157), which, among other provisions, extends the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) through September 30, 2019. The president signed the bill on June 6, 2019, more than a week before the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) was set to expire. In addition to the extension through September, according to informed sources, House Financial Services Committee Chairwoman Maxine Waters and Ranking Member Patrick McHenry announced that they have reached an agreement on a five-year extension of the NFIP. The law firm will continue to monitor and report on the NFIP's status.
