

NEW REG E FINAL RULE ON REMITTANCE TRANSFERS

s mandated by Dodd-Frank, in February 2012 the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau issued a final rule amending Regulation E to impose a number of disclosure and error resolution requirements for consumer remittance transfers to foreign countries. On the same date, the Bureau also published a proposed rule that addressed certain issues, including disclosure and receipt requirements for remittance transfers scheduled in advance and a further explanation of the scope of the rule, including when financial institutions are considered to be conducting remittance transfers in the "normal course of business."

On August 7, 2012, the Bureau released its final rule on the proposal. This final rule increased the originally proposed threshold for remittance transfers provided in the "normal course of business" and adjusted some of the disclosure rules for remittance transfers scheduled in advance. The effective date for both rules remains February 7, 2013.
